Article topic:

Topics related to economic development and cooperation in the Asia-Pacific region include (energy, sustainable development/net-zero transition, international relations, economic transformation, digital economy, political and economic trends in the Asia-Pacific region, trade and investment, women's economy, climate, food security and health security, etc.).

Article length:

Around 1,800 to 2,000 words (with an upper limit of 2,000).

Compensation:

3.75 NTD per word, in line with government regulations. (For a 2,000-word piece, that's about 7,500 NTD, roughly 240 USD.)

Format:

Welcome to include charts or tables (original or free to use), as well as annotations and references in footnote format.

CTPECC publishes the Issue Paper quarterly, four issues per year. We aim to share insights from industry, government, and academia with local knowledge to analyze the significance and feasibility of Asia-Pacific regional cooperation.
